You can use <u>sharecharlotte.org</u> to find virtual volunteer opportunities. SHARE Charlotte offers simple ways to engage with 450+ local nonprofits.




On <u>sharecharlotte.org</u> choose "Volunteer" and you can filter down to find the causes you care about! Choose the "Location - Work from Anywhere" for virtual volunteer opportunities.

Continue to select filters on the left hand side of the page to narrow down your search even further and find the opportunity that is a perfect match based on the causes you care about or skill set you want to use.

Once you click on an opportunity and "apply", you'll be connected directly with that nonprofit to work out the volunteer opportunity details. It doesn't commit you to the opportunity.





Virtual Volunteering ideas for your Target Learning Outcomes

- I. Awareness: Become more aware of your strengths and areas for growth
 - → Idea: Create math flashcards for Classroom Central
- II. Global Value: Develop international mindedness through global engagement, multilingualism and intercultural understanding.
 - → Idea: Write an encouraging note to an artisan for <u>Fashion and Compassion</u>
- III. Perseverance: Persevere in action
 - → Idea: Clean up your neighborhood for <u>Anne Springs Close Greenway</u>
- IV. Collaboration: Work collaboratively with others
 - → Idea: Make sandwiches with friends for Roof Above.
- V. Ethics: Consider the ethical implications of your actions
 - → Idea: Help improve equity and equality for all as a Queen City Unity Ambassador.
- VI. Initiative: Discuss, evaluate, and plan student initiated activities
 - → Idea: Create snack bags young girls in need for Foundation for Girls
- VII. Challenge & New Skills: Undertake challenges that develop new skill
 - → Idea: Become a social media champion for the <u>American Cancer Society</u>.

Note: You do not have to complete one volunteer activity per Target Learning Outcomes - one activity could include several outcomes.

Important reminders:

- Submit your SA activity through ManageBac for approval first before beginning your volunteer activity.
- Take pictures during your volunteer activity to be used as evidence.
- Once your volunteer activity is complete, select <u>Add New Reflection & Evidence</u> to submit your reflection and evidence of your volunteer experience
